






Average Cycle for Anesthesiology = 4.00 years

Integrated Clinical Base Years




Common Citations 2010-2012

74% of citations in 5 categories





ACGME Monitoring Committee

- Reviews Resident Survey Data for all specialties
- Determines programs that are non-compliant
 - Duty hours
 - Duty hours + other categories
- Anesthesiology RRC reviewed these programs and will require an improvement plan



New Areas of ACGME Interest

- Training in Quality/Patient Safety
- Training in Team Work/Leadership
- Training in Clinical Resource Stewardship
 - Cost effectiveness
 - Health Services Delivery
 - “Choosing Wisely” Program
 - Comparative effectiveness research
- Next Accreditation System/CLER Surveys

Eligibility Requirements

ACGME Board proposed and posted for comment in 2011:

- Prerequisite clinical education for entry into ACGME accredited core residency program must be accomplished in an ACGME or RCPSC (Canada) program
- Prerequisite clinical education for entry into ACGME accredited fellowship program must be accomplished in an ACGME or RCPSC (Canada) core residency program



Eligibility Requirement - time frame

Proposed Implementation dates

- July 1, 2014 - For entry into core program
- July 1, 2015 - For entry into fellowship program

Still waiting on finalization for these – probably will not know before the end of 2012
